

Submission Guidelines for Innopharma Insights

The Innopharma Journal aims to highlight the diverse and exciting range of research activities taking place at Innopharma Education. With a focus on innovation and current trends, the journal emphasizes research and discussion within the domains of Digital Transformation, Pharmaceutical Business and Technology, Medical Device Technology, Food Business and Technology and Sustainability.

The journal welcomes submissions from staff and students on all of the above subject areas and encourages accessible content, which will engage a broad academic audience.

1. General Requirements

- Submissions must be original and not under consideration for publication elsewhere.
- Contributions should be from current students, recent graduates (within two years of graduation) or current staff.
- All submissions should adhere to the ethical standards of [academic integrity](#).
- Topics must align with the aims and scope of the journal.

2. Submission Types

Research Articles: Comprehensive analyses of topics relevant to the journal's scope. Must include a clear methodology, results, and discussion.

Opinion Pieces: Critical essays expressing viewpoints on current trends or debates within the covered fields.

Letters to the Editor: Short communications commenting on previously published articles or ongoing research.

Book Reviews: Critiques of recent books relevant to the fields of the journal. Should provide summary, evaluation, and implications for the field.

Conference Reports: Summaries of academic conferences, highlighting key speeches, presentations, and emerging research trends.

3. Manuscript Preparation

Format: Manuscripts must be typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced, and should have 1-inch margins on all sides.

Length: Research articles should be between 2,000 and 4,000 words, including references and appendices. Book reviews, conference reports, opinion pieces and other content types should be between 500-2000 words.

Title Page: Should include the title, author(s)' name(s), affiliation(s), and a contact email address.

Abstract: Not exceeding 250 words, summarizing the main arguments and conclusions of the article.

Research Articles should include the following sections:

Title: A clear and concise title that accurately reflects the content and scope of the research.

Abstract: The abstract should be self-contained, citation-free, and should not exceed 300 words.

Keywords: Provide 4 to 6 keywords that describe the main topics of the paper.

Introduction: A succinct introduction, with no headings, to include a background, problem statement (defining the problem or challenge addressed by the research), objectives and significance of the research.

Literature review: A detailed review of existing research relevant to the topic. This section should synthesize key themes, identify gaps in the current literature, and position the current research within the existing academic discourse.

Methodology: Describe the research design, data sources, analytical techniques, and tools used.

Results: Presents the findings of the research in a logical sequence, using tables, figures, and charts to illustrate data where appropriate. This section should be clear and concise, directly correlating with the research objectives.

Discussion: Interpret the results, discuss their implications in the context of the identified problem and the broader field of the subject.

Conclusions: Summarise the key findings and their implications, addressing the research objectives and offering conclusions based on the results.

Recommendations (optional): Provides actionable suggestions based on the research findings.

Acknowledgements (optional): Recognizes individuals or organizations that contributed significantly to the research but do not qualify as authors.

References: List all sources cited in the article, following the Harvard referencing style.

4. Review Process

- All submissions are subject to a peer-review process by a panel.
- Feedback will typically be provided within 4 weeks from the submission date.

5. Submission Procedure

- Manuscripts should be submitted electronically to journal@innopharmalabs.com
- Correspondence, including the submission and review process, will be conducted via email.

6. Copyright and Licensing

- Upon acceptance, authors agree to transfer copyright of the published article to the Innopharma Education journal.
- Articles will be published under a Creative Commons license, allowing others to share the work with an acknowledgement of the work's authorship and initial publication in this journal.

7. Ethics and Consent

- Research involving human subjects must adhere to ethical standards and where applicable, authors should include a statement confirming that consent was obtained from all participants.
- These guidelines are designed to ensure that all contributions are of high quality and relevance, enhancing the scholarly impact and reach of the journal.
